












EDA INVESTMENT PRIORITIES

★ projects that build economic resilience to and long-term recovery from economic shocks, like those experienced by coal and power plant communities, or other communities impacted by the decline of an important industry or a natural disaster, that may benefit from economic diversification-focused resilience.

Workforce Development



Economic development planning or implementation projects that support workforce education and skills training activities directly connected to the hiring and skills needs of the business community and that result in well-paying, quality jobs.









Technology-Based Economic Development



Consistent with a Regional

★ Public Works and Economic Adjustment – Implementation projects MUST be consistent with a relevant Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy (CEDS)

★ Proposals specifically prioritized in a CEDS are typically more competitive
